Take your first step in preventing illegal dumping

In Victoria, it's illegal to dump or bury litter or waste on public or private land or into water without the appropriate authorisation. You can only dispose of it in locations that are licensed to accept it.

Illegally dumped waste can be anything from a single bag of household rubbish to bigger items such as TVs, fridges and mattresses, to building and demolition materials, oils and paints, and old tyres. Illegal dumping can pose a risk to your health and negatively affect the liveability of an area.

What if you catch someone dumping rubbish?

- Call Crimestoppers on 1800 333 000 while they're doing it
- If you find dumped rubbish report it to Environment Protection Authority online or by calling 1300 372 842. You can remain anonymous.
- You can also report it on Snap Send Save which sends the photos to your local council.
- Users can capture a photo, provide a description, and submit the report in under 30 seconds. Councils have a dedicated form on their website to report waste dumping. If the dumped rubbish has damaged personal property, call the Police Assistance Line on 131 444
